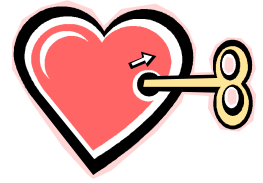


# *Sickening Sweet Box Auction*

We will be holding our annual Sickening Sweet Box Auction on Tuesday, February 14th. Students are asked to decorate a box (shoe box or smaller), fill it with goodies (both edible and/or non-edible), and bring it to school on the 14th. Homemade goodies are always a treat and typically more economical. Students will then have the opportunity to bid on their favorite box during a class auction (using classroom BUCKS, of course). **Creativity is key**, as students will only see the outside of the boxes prior to the auction and will not be able to open the box that they have won until all boxes have been bid on. PATIENCE!!!

Boxes are to be brought to school in a **paper** grocery bag with the top folded over and stapled. This way no one can see the boxes as students are bringing them to school. There will be a "viewing session" prior to the auction so that students can look at all of the boxes before bidding begins.

This is an optional activity, however, students must understand that if they **choose to not bring a box, they may not bid on a box**. Students who have been classroom volunteers and have not received classroom BUCKS will still be able to participate. Their boxes will be auctioned off first, providing them with BUCKS to use. These students should label their brown bag "VOLUNTEER" so that we know which boxes to auction off first.

This will be our Valentine's Day party! Therefore, we are hoping that all students will choose to participate so that they can be active during all the fun.
